Cookies statement

To make the site of Ministry of Labour, Social Affairs and Family Slovak Republic work properly, we sometimes place small data files called cookies on your device. Most big websites do this too.

What are cookies?

A cookie is a small text file that a website saves on your computer or mobile device when you visit the site. It enables the website to remember your actions and preferences (such as login, language, font size and other display preferences) over a period of time, so you don't have to keep re-entering them whenever you come back to the site or browse from one page to another of the site.

A cookie can be classified by its lifespan and the domain to which it belongs. By lifespan, a cookie is either a:

- **session cookie** which is erased when the user closes the browser *or*
- **persistent cookie** which remains on the user's computer/device for a pre-defined period of time.

How to control cookies

You can **control and/or delete** cookies as you wish - for details, see [AllAboutCookies.org](#). You can delete all cookies that are already on your computer and you can set most browsers to prevent them from being placed. If you do this, however, you will not be able to use some functionalities of this site and you may have to manually adjust some preferences every time you visit a site and some services and functionalities may not work.
